The Mercy Foundation's Grants to End Homelessness program is for initiatives above \$5,000 and no more than \$60,000 per year. **The Mercy Foundation does not provide recurrent funding for projects.**

The focus is on initiatives that have the potential to make a contribution to **ending and/or preventing homelessness in Australia,** particularly where women are concerned. We provide **seed funding** to projects that build capacity and help create structural change and have the potential to continue after the funding period.

This grants program prioritises **permanent solutions** to people's homelessness. Crisis or short term responses are not funded by this grants program.

If your EOI is successful, we will invite you to submit an extended application form. Moving to the next round following this EOI process is no guarantee that the Mercy Foundation will provide a grant for your project.
